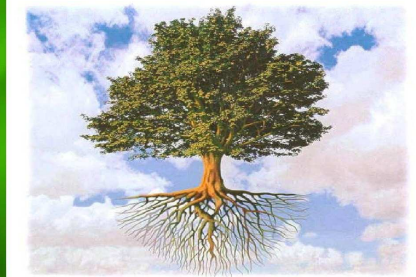

Biography of Howard Dwight, DC

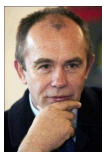

Over his nearly 27 years of private practice he has diversified his research and experience in multiple areas related to chiropractic and healing. Specifically, his professional training and background of study includes: Board eligible for fellowship/certification from the American College of Functional Neurology in Vestibular Rehabilitation, Childhood Developmental Disorders, Neurochemistry and Nutrition.
